

- 1. Gender differences are innate

- 3. We are broken, and acting against our created nature leads to harm on many levels




IS GENDER A SOCIAL CONSTRUCT?



Largest ever study examining sex differences (n>670,000)


Females higher in Empathy Quotient (EQ)

Males higher in Systems Quotient (SQ)



MALE AND FEMALE BRAINS?

- Function, not structure
- Hormonal influences (CAH-afflicted females)
- Testosterone, Androgen receptors, CAG codon

IMPORTANT CAVEATS

- Both masculine and feminine personae exist along a continuum
- Some gender roles indeed are socially and culturally determined
- Significant overlap is inevitable but varies with trait
- Many gender differences actual decrease with age and experience

BIBLICAL SEXUALITY

- Incorporated into human design ("natural law")
- Lifelong, heterosexual monogamy
- Celibacy outside of marriage

- Diversity
- Complementarity
- Interdependence/Exchange
- Procreation

WHY COMPLEMENTARITY MATTERS

- ➤ Optimal for child-rearing
- Enhances maturity in a healthy relationship
- > Incentivizes personal growth
- > Optimal for household functioning
- >Optimal for long-term happiness and mental health

POSITIVE OUTCOMES OF MARRIAGE

- Higher levels of happiness
- Higher economic prosperity
- Higher level of physical health
- Increased longevity
- Children fare better by every measure


MARRIAGE AND HEALTH

What Do We Know About the Link Between Marriage and Health? Journal of Family Issues 31(8):1019-1040, 2010

- "Marriage reduces depression"
- "Unmarried adults are more likely to drink, use marijuana, and drive recklessly"
- "Married men and women experience lower mortality at every age relative to those who remain unmarried or lose their spouse through widowhood or divorce"
- "A number of rigorous studies reveal that marriage can also lead to better general physical health and better outcomes for some specific health conditions, including arthritis, hypertension, and heart disease"

NEUROCHEMISTRY OF SEX

- Dopamine
- Oxytocin (primarily females)
- Vasopressin (males)
- Rewires brain
- Self-sustaining



CONSEQUENCES OF THE FALL PART 3

EMOTIONAL CONSEQUENCES OF NONMARITAL SEX

- Depression
- 1.5-3.5x more likely to consider suicide
- Oxytocin-mediated bonding
- Multiple partners diminish capacity to form a committed relationship
- Women suffer more

MEDICAL CONSEQUENCES OF NONMARITAL SEX

- Pregnancy
 - Quoted efficacy of birth control assumes perfect compliance
 - Abortion as birth control
- STDs
- Death: AIDS, HPV, Violence

Reported STDs Reach All-time High for 6th Consecutive Year




SOCIAL CONSEQUENCES OF NONMARITAL SEX

- Reduced religious engagement
- More liberal political tendencies
- Masculine acedia
- Reduced marriage rate
- Reduced fertility

"CHEAP SEX"

- Males dominate the demand side for sex, females typically the "gatekeepers"
- Females dominate the market for marriage
- The "price" of sex is reflected in what it costs an individual to obtain a partner



"CHEAP SEX"

- The Pill
- Internet dating and smart phone apps "sex delivery system"
- Lower expectations from females
- Changing approach to marriage
- Pornography
- Marriage remains "expensive"


"Giving young men easy access to abundant sexual satisfaction deprives society of one of its ways to motivate them to contribute valuable achievements to the culture."

COHABITATION

- Less bonding
- Less intimacy
- Less sharing
- Less commitment
- Less financial security
- Puts children at risk

- More conflict
- More cheating
- Risk factor for future divorce

POLYGAMY

The impact of polygamy on women's mental health: a systematic review | Epidemiology and Psychiatric Sciences 22(1):47-62, 2013

"Individual studies report a higher prevalence of somatization, depression, anxiety, hostility, psychoticism and psychiatric disorder in polygynous wives as well as reduced life and marital satisfaction, problematic family functioning and low self-esteem."



"The Puzzle of Monogamous Marriage"

- Monogamous societies outperformed all others
- Lower crime
- Reduced gender inequality
- Improved economic productivity
- Less child neglect and abuse

CHILDREN'S RIGHTS

- Biological father
- Biological mother
- Stable home environment



THEM BEFORE US

- By almost every measurable parameter, children fare far better when raised by their married biological parents
- Safety
- Identity
- Mental and physical health
- Economic and academic success
- Social well-being

CONSEQUENCES OF THE FALL

- Wedge between men and women
- Corruption of marriage
- Corruption of sexuality
- Corruption of child rearing

SUMMATION

- Men and women are biologically different and complement one another
